

BIOPSY CARE

SHAVE BIOPSY

- 1. Leave bandage in place until the day after the procedure
- 2. Clean biopsy site with soap and water (it is okay to shower) NO hydrogen peroxide
- 3. Apply Aquaphor or Vaseline to site & cover with a new bandaid/bandage until site heals
- 4. It may take 2-3 weeks for site to heal, or even longer if abnormal cells are still present
- 5. If biopsy site starts to bleed, apply direct pressure for 10-15 minutes

BIOPSY WITH SUTURES

- 1. If your biopsy has sutures, they should be removed in _____ days
- 2. If your biopsy has sutures, you may use hydrogen peroxide to remove blood
- 3. Do not allow sutures to be submersed in water (swimming pool/hot tub)

Please call the office at 970-247-1970 if there are any signs of infection, excess pain or bleeding (some redness and weeping around biopsy site is a normal part of healing)

OCCASIONALLY, A BIOPSY MAY BE SENT TO AN OUTSIDE LAB FOR SPECIAL STAINS AND/OR ADDITIONAL CONSULT. YOU MAY RECEIVE A BILL FROM AN OUTSIDE LAB FOR THESE SERVICES.
